



Announcement from the Sports Authority of Thailand

Subject: Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts for Performing Duties (No Gift Policy) Fiscal Year 2026

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Sports Authority of Thailand (SAT) has a policy for the executives, officials, and employees of all levels to perform duties as good examples with honesty and transparency, and resist all forms of corruption and misconduct, including not accepting presents and gifts of all kinds while, before, and after performing duties to create a culture of honesty and good values in performing duties in the organization as well as conduct themselves exactly according to the relevant laws and regulations.

By virtue of Section 23 of the Sports Authority of Thailand Act B.E. 2558 (2015), SAT would like to implement the Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts for Performing Duties (No Gift Policy) and hereby declares that SAT is a government organization where government officials do not accept all kinds of presents and gifts while, before, and after performing duties. The executives, officials, and employees of SAT strictly adhere to the following practices:

1. Do not seek to obtain presents, souvenirs and gifts or any other benefits from personnel involved in the performance of duties.
2. Do not give and accept property or any other benefits.
3. Do not consent or connive with family members in giving or accepting presents and gifts or any other benefits from personnel involved in the performance of duties.
4. In case where it is obligatory to give or accept property or any other benefits as to be expected of ethics, morality, tradition or in order to maintain good relations between individuals, before giving or accepting presents, souvenirs, gifts, or any other benefits all must comply with the relevant laws, rules and regulations. The items or gifts or any other benefits given or received must have a value not exceeding 3,000 baht from each person on each occasion and if the value of the items are exceeding 3,000 baht, they must be reported to the commanders.

5. It is advocated...

5. It is advocated to use greeting cards and congratulations cards instead of gifts for the benefit of strengthening the attitude towards saving and sufficiency. It is favored to give sports equipment in lieu of presents, souvenirs, gifts, or any other benefits to other organizations which are in need of sports development, by this way, we can also promote the display of corporate social responsibility.
